KEY ACCOMPLISHMENTS

ALIGNED PARTNERSHIPS

- Penn State College of Medicine, CDC REACH (Racial & Ethnic Approaches
 to Community Health) has expanded to York County and selected
 Healthy York as a strategic partner. The national program focuses on the
 Hispanic and Latino population to reduce racial and ethnic health
 disparities,.
 - Through collaboration the first year included:
 - Assessment of community health needs
 - Hired a REACH project consultant
 - Completion of CDC Active Communities Modules
 - Convening community stakeholders that align with REACH's focus areas
 - More to come in Year 2!

CONVENING COMMUNITY PARTNERS AROUND SHARED GOALS

- In concert with York County Care Coordination project; now Connect York, Healthy York has been supporting through leadership and strategic direction the Bi-Directional & Shared Intake Committee.
 - Key Project deliverables included:
 - Systems mapping & evaluating needs for resource navigation
 - Review & creation of shared intake forms
 - Development of RFP process for selected vendors
 - Creation & evaluation of scoring rubric
 - Recruitment of pilot organizations for Connect York
- Conducted environmental scans to inform health care and community partners on Community Health Improvement Plan areas in York County including housing, charitable food system, mental health services and public health.
- In partnership with the York County Coroner and Child Death Review Team, we have convened community partners surrounding gun deaths and developed a framework for the York County Gun Safety Initiative. Through cross sector collaboration, the Initiative is a strategic approach to addressing gun safety in York County, leveraging data, storytelling, community engagement and education to create a safer environment for all residents.

KEY ACCOMPLISHMENTS

COMMUNITY GATHERINGS

- Healthy York Coalition convened community partners at our February 2024 Health Forum at Penn State York. "Collaborative Approaches to Community Health". From health care, government, public health and health and human service organizations gathered together to hear about key community health data, critical projects and initiatives including:
 - Launch of the York County Care Coordination Project, now Connect York
 - Food Insecurity Data
 - Housing Data
 - Key SDOH topics for Healthy Neighborhoods
 - Introduction to CDC REACH


